As a faculty in Alfort he has been focusing most of his work on dog's nutrition and working dogs' performance for the last 25 years, with a special attention to oxidative stress prevention and consequences. Dr. Jerry Vanek, MS, DVM, Minnesota, USA

Jerry Vanek is a veterinarian and a canine physiotherapeut with many years of experience with hard working sleddogs and their medical problems.
